#### **ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT INCENTIVE OPPORTUNITIES**

The City of Lovington has resources available to assist businesses wishing to relocate or expand in the City of Lovington. The Lovington Economic Development Executive Board, along with its Due Diligence Committee, works through the City of Lovington, to qualify applicants and to negotiate agreements that allow businesses to take advantage of these resources.

#### **INCENTIVE OPPORTUNITIES INCLUDE:**

Lease of City of Lovington-owned properties Property tax abatements Industrial revenue bonds Infrastructure improvement Industrial park
Access to loan funds
Job training funds
Customized incentives

#### **Eligibility**

Any existing or proposed corporation, Limited Liability Company, partnership, joint venture, syndicate, association or other person is eligible provided that it meets one or more of the following criteria:

- A. An industry for the manufacturing, processing, or assembling of any agricultural or manufactured products;
- B. A commercial enterprise for storing, warehousing, distributing, or selling products of agriculture, mining or industry, but, other than provided in Paragraph (D) below, not including any enterprise for sale of goods or commodities at retail or for the distribution to the public of electricity, gas, water, or telephone or other services commonly classified as public utilities;
- C. A business in which all or part of the activities of the business involves the supplying of services to the general public or to governmental agencies or to a specific industry or customer, but, other than provided in Paragraph (D) below, not including businesses primarily engaged in the sale of goods or commodities at retail;
- D. A telecommunications sales enterprise that makes the majority of its sales to persons outside of New Mexico.

#### **Application process**

The process for awarding economic development incentives is governed by the City's Economic Development Plan Ordinance (City Ordinance No. 495) and NMSA 1978 Section 5-10-1 through 5-10-13. The basic steps in the process are as follows:

- Lovington EDC Executive Board, Due Diligence Committee Chair and City Attorney ("Oversight Committee") will meet with the applicant to determine eligibility for incentives offered through the City of Lovington. Through discussion of specific needs the Oversight Committee along with the applicant, will come up with a preliminary plan of action.
- 2. A formal application for incentives is submitted through the information requested in this packet. The Lovington EDC Executive Board will assign a Due Diligence Committee who will review the information to qualify applicant as a viable business partner, and to determine the economic benefits of the business to the community. All of the information requested is *required by law* before any economic development incentives can be provided.
- 3. Once an application is received, the Due Diligence Committee will determine the specific incentives to be recommended to the applicant. The amount and type of incentives offered will correlate directly to the positive economic impact that the project will have on the community (Cost/Benefit Analysis).
- 4. Lovington EDC Executive Board and Due Diligence Committee will prepare and present the Cost/Benefit Analysis and Recommendations to the EDC Board of Directors
- 5. Upon approval, a closed session presentation of the Cost/Benefit analysis and recommended incentives will be made to the City Commission.
- 6. Upon approval by the city commission, the Lovington EDC will assist the City of Lovington in the preparation of a formal Project Participation Agreement, outlining the exact responsibilities of each party. This agreement will be in accordance with City of Lovington Ordinance No. 495
- 7. The City of Lovington's Commission will make a final determination on the Agreement at a public hearing.
